I write regarding the plans of the Northern Midlands Council to place The Holy Trinity Church, Cressy on a Heritage List.

Whilst we understand the motives behind this move and are not opposed to it we do have a few concerns about it.

We are hopeful that our submission to Diocesan Council to have the Church removed from the scheduled list of properties for sale will be successful, we realise that if nothing is done the Parish will not exist in a few years from now. To prevent this from happening we need to modernise both our services and our infrastructure to make it all 'user friendly' and attractive to more people.

Part of this planning will involve changes to the interior of the Church, such as the removal of the pews and replacing them with chairs, carpeting the floor, possibly removing the pulpit so that the TV Screen can be better placed and used during services. These changes will enable us to make better use of the space available.

We are a little concerned that if the Church was placed on a Heritage Listing, we might have problems carrying out these changes without a great deal of work involved compared to now.

So, whilst we are not averse to the plans of the Council, we would like some advice as to the concerns above.

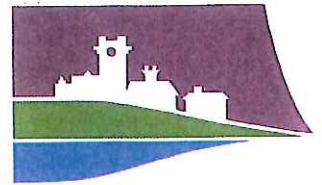
