Council is due to determine the 2023/2024 municipal budget, and in doing so, we also reflect on what has been achieved. Here is a snapshot of some of the projects that were completed.

Contractors were engaged to remove weathered, rotten weather boards and replace with new at Fall Park in Evandale.

- Replacement of bridges on Jones Road, Liffey Road and Blackwood Creek Road.
