

Our Family Friendly, Northern Midlands

Council is proud of its 13, family friendly parks that are packed with a range of equipment for your enjoyment including open spaces, playgrounds, barbeque facilities, and public toilets, open 7 days a week.

Victoria Square (Village Green), located on Wellington Street in **Longford** and boasts power, barbeque facilities and electronic equipment for 12 years and over, while the skate park, and Road Safety Park an also be found nearby on the corner of Archer Street and Latour Street. Everyone is welcome with something for all ages and abilities.

For something a little smaller or perhaps closer to home, don't forget **Summerfield Park** on the corner of Lewis and Marlborough Streets in Longford.

Updated in 2022, the **Seccombe Street Park** in **Perth** provides a great space for local families and friends to gather with traffic calming (speed hump) due to be installed to slow the traffic in the area.

Valentines Park is located on High Street in the centre of Campbell Town. Enjoyed by local families, and with plenty of parking, it's within walking distance to dining, takeaway food, and shopping, and is the ideal place to stop and stretch your legs when travelling including refurbished toilets.

If you're in Campbell Town and are looking for something a bit more passive, then **Blackburn Park** or **Lions Park** may be the answer. Both overlooking the Elizabeth River, these locations provide you the opportunity for either some quiet time or family fun.

Upgraded in 2020, **Boucher Park** in **Avoca** is a toddler paradise including a tractor-slide, sheep shaped rocker and basket swing – designed to incorporate a farm theme in keeping with the rural location.
