

## Trooper Henry Mitchell Black Memorial Cressy

Memorial erected in memory of Trooper Henry Mitchell Black who served during the Boer War. The memorial is made of grey granite. The base is fashioned in a pedestal style with the front bearing the inscription. On top of the pedestal is an obelisk. At the front of the obelisk are two rifles crossed and at the top is a scroll and wreath.
